Memberships are limited to the first 250 applicants.**

POOL RULES

1. Members and guests must be signed in by a member of the pool staff at the front desk as they enter the gate for each visit.
2. No one is allowed in the pool with open sores.
3. No smoking is allowed inside the pool fence or by the registration desk.
4. No horseplay, roughhousing, running or pushing of any kind is allowed. Failure to comply with rules will result in the following intervention strategies and disciplinary measures.

First Daily Offense:	Warning or up to a 15 minute time out
Second Daily Offense:	Up to a 30 minute time out
Third Daily Offense:	Expulsion from the SHRC premises for the remainder of the day.

Defiance of SHRC personnel's authority, refusing punishment, abusive language, fighting or any other non specified disruptive behavior that threatens the safety and well being of other members or guests will result in immediate expulsion from SHRC premises for the remainder of the day.

5. Eating is not allowed in or around the pool deck. Please use the picnic area and tables for snacking and meals.
6. Squirt guns or water guns are NOT allowed.
7. One person at a time permitted on diving board and ladders.
8. No pets allowed inside pool fence.
9. Parents are responsible for all non-swimmers in the pool area.
Parents are also responsible for children in the baby pool as there is no lifeguard on duty in this area.
10. No diving from the sides is allowed in the pool except in the deep in and during "open pit."



11. Opening and closing of the pool in inclement weather is at the discretion of the pool manager.
12. The pool management may curtail or restrict any activity on SHRC

property that interferes, endangers, or otherwise affects the security and enjoyment of other members.

Repeated failure to follow the Pool's rules or respect SHRC personnel's authority could result in additional limitations and possible loss of membership privileges. At the discretion of the Board of Directors, membership privileges may be terminated for failure to follow SHRC rules and policies. A member(s) whose annual membership is terminated will receive a pro-rated refund of dues paid. The decision of the Board regarding membership termination will be final.

BABY POOL RULES

1. Children 6 and under **ONLY** are allowed to swim in the baby pool.

NO EXCEPTIONS!

2. All children must be accompanied by an adult if inside the fenced pool area. **NOTE:** There is no lifeguard on duty in this area!

3. Eating and drinking are not allowed at the side or inside the baby pool.

4. Children in diapers must wear swim diapers in the baby pool. Regular diapers are not allowed.



GUEST RULES

Guests are welcome at Scenic Hills Recreation Club. However, we have instituted the following rules to comply with state laws, to protect the club from liability, and to prevent persons from taking advantage of their guest status in lieu of purchasing a membership.

*Guest policies apply to persons using the pool and/ or tennis court. They do not apply to tennis spectators or to the occasional visitor in street clothes who is at the pool to watch a swimmer.

*A sponsoring member must accompany guests at all times.

*POOL MANAGEMENT MUST CHECK IN ALL GUESTS and have the guest complete the "SHRC Visitor Information" form.

*Guest fees are \$5 per person per day and will be applied toward membership fees if the guest chooses to purchase a membership.

*NO Memphis metro area (Shelby, Fayette, Tipton & Desoto counties) residents may attend as a guest more than 1 time per month (even with multiple members sponsoring and accompanying said guest). Guests who would like to visit the pool more than 1 time per month should purchase a membership.

*Members 13-17 years of age may bring one 13-17 year old guest without an adult or responsible guardian present if both member and guest are swimmers.

*Guest fees apply during club sponsored parties or other social events including the Potluck Dinners.

*Out-of-town visitors who are houseguests of a member may be admitted after paying the guest fee of \$5 per day for up to 7 days during pool season.

*All rules, regulations, and policies of SHRC apply to all guests who visit the club.



GENERAL RULES

*Non-swimmers, 17 years of age or younger, must be supervised at all times by an adult or responsible guardian. A non-swimmer is anyone who cannot swim the length of the pool.

*Swimmers, 13 years of age or older, are allowed to swim at the pool without an adult or responsible guardian present if they can swim one lap of the pool.



NOTE: Swim privileges will be revoked for any child at the pool without an adult who does not follow pool rules and the instructions of the life guards and/or pool management.

*No cut-offs or street clothes are allowed in the pool. Swim suits are required. Cotton t-shirts are allowed in the pool if worn over an appropriate swim suit.

*Any child in diapers must wear a SWIM DIAPER while in the pool. Regular diapers of any kind are not allowed in the pool.

*Food and drink should be in non-breakable containers.



*Please keep all food in the table area by the snack bar.

*Bicycle riders are to walk their bikes up and down the walkway from the parking lot to the pool. No motor vehicles are allowed to drive up the walkway without approval of the pool management. Skates, rollerblades, skateboards, and motorized all terrain vehicles may not be used anywhere on the club.

*Opening and closing of “the pit” (diving board area) is at the discretion of the lifeguards. Open pit means free swim with diving off the sides allowed. Closed pit means no free swimming and diving only from the board.

*Adult swim is the last 10 minutes of every hour. No one under the age of 18 (with the exception of the lifeguards) is permitted in the pool at this time. This rule includes the pool steps.

*All items left at the pool are placed in the Lost and Found box. This box is cleaned out once each week and all unclaimed items are donated to charity.

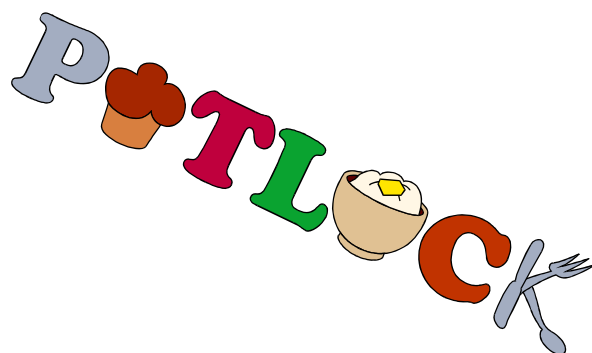
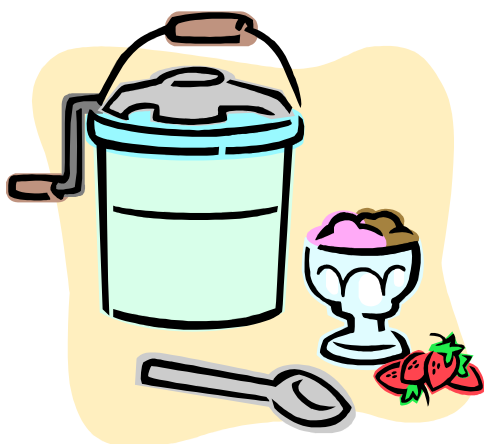
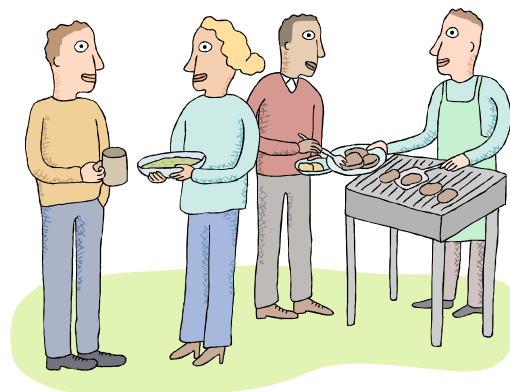
*Talking to the lifeguards while they are on the stands is prohibited. Please understand that this rule is for the safety of our members.

*Please do not hang towels to dry on the west fence next to the pool entrance. This blocks the view of our parking area which must be supervised by our pool staff.

*Closing due to inclement weather is at the discretion of the pool management and must be approved by the Board of Directors. Any change on the operation hours of the pool will be indicated by a message on our voice mail system (357-9610.) This message will include information pertinent to the situation for that day. Please call the pool if you have any questions about the weather before you leave home!

POOL SPONSORED SOCIAL EVENTS

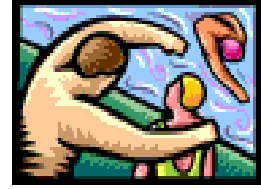

SWIMMING LESSONS

Swim lessons are free, and all swim courses are taught by a Red Cross Certified Instructors. The instructors will be assisted by staff lifeguards. American Red Cross criteria will be used to determine levels for our swim lessons. Note: To enter Level 1, a child must be at least 2 years of age and comfortable in the water. These lessons are not “water babies” sessions. Registration for swim lessons will be posted. Morning and evening sessions will be offered this year in an effort to accommodate all members. Please have your child at the pool and ready to enter the water at least 5 minutes before your class is scheduled to begin.



SWIM TEAM

Swim team is open to any member ages 4—19.

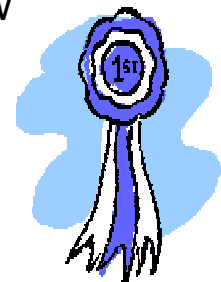


The swim team fee is \$50 per swimmer. This includes league fees. Team suits, t-shirts and swim caps are also available for purchase. The SHRC “Sharks” compete against other clubs in the Memphis Summer Swim League. MSSL is a recreational swim league. Head Coach for this year’s team is Sarah Knoll. The coach will evaluate swimmers and place them in the appropriate practice group according to skill level. Evaluations will take place during the first 2 weeks of practice.

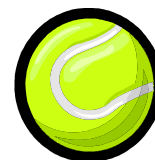

TENNIS RULES



Players must wear shirts and tennis shoes.

No food or drink other than water or sports drinks are allowed on the courts.

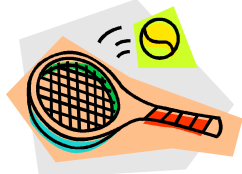
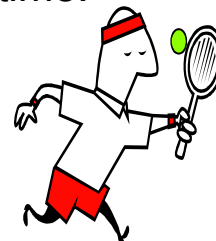
No smoking is allowed.

No radios, CD players or boom boxes are allowed.

No more than 4 people are allowed on one court at a time.

Spectators must remain outside the tennis fence.

All those using the courts must close the gate.

Guests must be accompanied by a member. Only one guest per member is allowed.

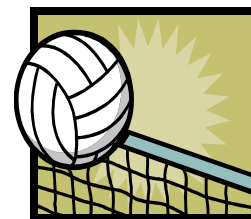
Guest fees are \$5 per person and must be paid at the pool desk.

BEACH VOLLEYBALL

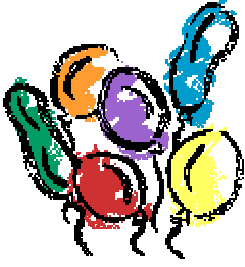
A sand volleyball court is located outside the pool fence near the patio area.



4-SQUARE

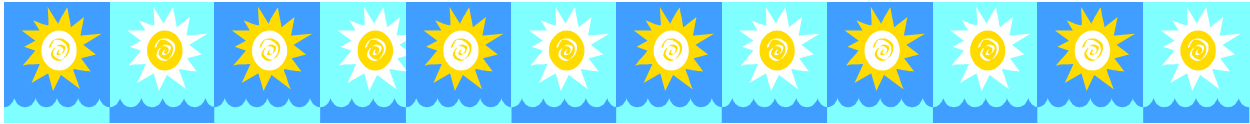
A 4-square court is located in the fenced games area at the west side of the pool.

POOL PARTY POLICY



This is the BEST deal in town! Where else can you have a kid's party for \$4 per child? You won't have to worry about entertainment because it's all here and best of all... you won't have to worry about all of the spills on that new carpet in the living room!

The following guide lines are for private parties held during regular operating hours of the pool:



- a) Only members may have a party.
- b) Pool Party forms must be completed by all those requesting reservations.
- c) Reservations must be made with pool management at the front desk.
- d) There is a \$4 charge for each guest (this is \$1 off the regular guest fee). Members are free.
- e) Parties are limited to 50 participants.

The following guidelines are for private parties not held during regular operating hours:

- a) #2 a-c above are required for after hours parties.
- b) The pool rental fee is \$25/hr or \$4 per non-member guest (which ever is higher) with a minimum of 2 hours charge per party.
- c) Parties may not exceed 3 hours in length.
- d) Additional fees for pool management and life guards will be required as well. Check with management if you are interested in this type of party.
